- Higher Education Requirement: 2-year or higher degree required
- **Practice Setting:** Can practice in: clinic/healthcare agency (c), home (h), both (b), ihs only (i)
- **Health Promotion:** Provides community-aligned health education, promotion, and outreach as central job function
- **Administration:** Administers medication, treatment, and tests; CHAPs can prescribe and dispense medication in accordance with their medical standing orders
- Practices Independently: Authorized to practice independently without constant, direct supervision
- **Billing:** Can bill at, or at a percentage of, the encounter rate
